A-4Q ARA Armada Argentina



This is a complete Aircraft with attached Panel & Sound ... and based on the A4 Project of Denis da Silva -Oliveira.

Installation :

Just unzip this to a temporay Folder and run **A4Q-ARA.exe**

Either Full Installation : Aircraft, Panel & Sound or Light for the Aircraft only. I assemble all currently available and my Liveries in four (4) Aircraft Containers and fitted them for the both released Models by Mr. da Silva. So from each Livery i get out two Aircrafts - one with Arms and Droptank one without. If you want to do so, you can use this Installation for Package 1 like i tell you on the next Page.

A-4 & TA-4 Repaints Documentation

1. Step rename this *A-4Q Skyhawk Armada Argentina* to *A-4 Skyhawk diverse 1* or similar
2. Step backup the *Aircraft.cfg* and rename *Package_01_Aircraft.cfg* to *Aircraft.cfg*
3. Step Download the Original Single Seater Archive from Mr.daSilva-O. „FA-1 Falcones do Mar“ get the Texture Folder and rename it to ***texture.mdb*** then move it to this Package Container.
4. Step Download the following File :
www.simviation.com/files/military/A-4_IAF.zip by Justin Lamb
This is the A-4H/N as it used by the IAF Isreal Air Force ... rename the Texture Folder to ***texture.iaf*** move it to this Package.
5. Step Download the following File :
www.simviation.com/files/military/A-4_KU.zip by Justin Lamb
This is the A4KU as it used by the Kuwaiit Air Force ... rename the Texture Folder to ***texture.kuaf*** move it to this Package.
6. Step Download the following File :
[a-4ar.zip](#) by Julio Limardo
This is the A4AR as it used by the Argentine Air Force ... rename the Texture Folder to ***texture.faa*** move it to this Package.

Genaerally you will find the attached Panel, wich comes from Mr.Paolo Dessani (Thanks for it) and the attached Lear Sound under :

FSFSCONV\panel.A4_2k2
FSFSCONV\sound.A4

if anyone has or knew a better sound config than the Lear ... he/she can store it here .. (i'm happy if getting Notice about better soundfile config)...

All needed Gauges are installed to the FS 2k2 Gauges Folder directly.

After Installation :

You will find this or the other Aircraft under McDonnell-Douglas in the Aircraft menu ... the Types are different .

If you fly manually ... you might recognized that she's going down ... say's she's constantly loose height ... , when taxiing on Ground ... beware of the Speed ... go slowly ... the Lady is fragile ... comes from her long „Leggs“ ... the Hook is combined with the Flaps ... and the Spoiler operates by normal Key # ... until now i don't find a suitable „Smoke“ Effect ... if someone would knew a Solution let me know ...

For Forcefeedback Joystick Users - i attached the original Lear section - because it's giving a better compromis between Feedbackforce and simulated Situation - the original was to hard ...

For those Users who understand and can read German Language ... there will be a Documentation aviable later but only in German ... it will give the Users more Information and a lot of Pictures of the A-4 / TA-4 Skyhawk ... if you want this Documentation or only the Graphics and Pictures of that please contact me
