

## London – Bankside

Freeware scenery for FS2002

In recent years Bankside, the area on the south bank of the Thames directly opposite St Pauls cathedral, has undergone major redevelopment and is now a popular tourist centre. It is linked to the South Bank and London Eye area via Oxo Wharf and the Millennium Mile riverside walk.

This scenery consists of the following prominent landmarks, essential to aid an easterly VFR approach to London City airport.

**Tate Modern gallery** – formerly Bankside powerstation

**The Millennium Bridge** – the first new bridge in central London for over a century

**The Globe Theatre** – a reconstruction of the original Shakespearean era open air theatre  
Several nearby restaurants, houses and office blocks.

This scenery is the second in my series of London add-ons. The first, South Bank (SE1v1.zip) contains the London Eye, Waterloo Station and Shell Centre, and an updated version of this will be released in May 2002.

### ADDING NEW SCENERY TO FS2002

Unzip banksV1.zip into the FS2002\ADDON SCENERY. A new folder, “Bankside”, will be created automatically for the scenery and texture files.

To register the new scenery in FS2002, at the FS2002 Start window select Settings, then Scenery Library. Choose Add Area and browse to the new Bankside folder. Select the Exclude scenery first and then the Bankside scenery (this is important as the exclude file must be registered first and be below bankside in the installed scenery list). All the scenery will be installed automatically into FS2002.

Create a new flight starting at London City Airport, runway 28. If you have installed Oliver Minchin's excellent Millennium Dome and Canary Wharf scenery you will fly directly over both as you head to the west (If you do not have this scenery go to [FlightSim.com](http://FlightSim.com) and download canaryv1.zip). Continue west over Tower Bridge and the Tower of London and you will find the new Bankside scenery to your left opposite St Pauls cathedral.
